<a href="#">SB 1414</a>	Hancock/ Phelan	Relating to fees regarding a residential tenant's failure to timely pay rent.	Adds that no portion of the fee is due to the failure to pay a late fee.	Failed
<a href="#">SB 1414</a>	Hancock/ Phelan	Relating to fees regarding a residential tenant's failure to timely pay rent.	Strikes the language that the late fee may be more than the amount under subdivision (1), but not more than the uncertain related damages to the landlord.	Failed
